Call to Order: 6:00pm

1. Reports:

1.1 Elsinore Cemetery District: Board member Karen Snyder, spoke about how the flood control project is nearing completion. She also spoke about the new memorial arch at the Elsinore Cemetery and how Elsinore Cemetery has a new website.

1.2 Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District: George Cambero shared with community members that he will be sworn in as the EVMWD Director this December. George spoke about his goal of improving water quality and finding other water resources such as ground water.

1.3 Riverside County Flood Control: Appointee Chris Hyland, spoke on the importance of channel clean up that the channels are still an issue. She warned of a coming flood this winter. She also reported there has been progress made on Collier Road, but it is still under construction.

1.4 Update from Assemblywoman Melissa Melendez's office: Deni Horne, shared that Melissa was sworn in this month for a two-year term. She also gave legislative update, shared how concerned Melissa Melendez is over college tuition increases and gas tax increase and that she is actively advocating stopping the tax increase. Deni encouraged community members to go online

to sign the petition to stop the gas tax increase. She also encouraged community members to support the Spark of Love Toy Drive.

1.5 Lakeland Village Neighborhood Watch: Encouraged community members to come to the next meeting and join the Watch to help keep the community safe.

1.6 Riverside Sheriff: Lt. Zach Hall, Riverside County Sheriff Department, Lt. Zach Hall reported on type 1 crimes. He also reported that there has been an increase in patrols in Lakeland Village and displaced homeless is still an issue in the community.

## 2. New Business:

2.1 Jerry Jolliffe, Planning Consultant RCTLMA- Riverside County General Plan Update Presentation: Jerry informed the community that Lakeland Village's general plan is being updated and that they need the communities input. The new plan will focus on long-term goals for over the next twenty years.

2.2 Sterlon Sims, Senior Development Specialist- CDBG Citizen Participation: Sterlon spoke about grants that are available to help in community developments such as youth programs and public services. She shared more information is available on the CDBG website.

2.3 Tina Koonce, Director Facilities & Operations- Lake Elsinore Unified School District. Future realignment of school attendance boundaries and grade configurations. Tina Koonce reported that Lakeland Village attendance boundaries are changing. LEUSD's goal is for all students to be able to go to the school closes to their home, to keep kids in their communities because it is what is best for kids.

3. Old Business: Lakeland Village Community Center, Kristen Huyck reported that the County is still working with the District on the purchase of property. County is researching ideas on how to keep the Community Center running once it is open. There is the possibility of renting space and building a skate park.

4. Update from the Office of Supervisor Kevin Jeffries: Kristen Huyck, Legislative Assistant reported that the new Fire Chief Mike Moore was sworn in since the last LV CAC meeting. She also reported Kevin Jeffries is continuing to work towards building a community center for Lakeland Village and improve road conditions in the area.

5. Public Comments: Community member: inquired about possibility of new cross streets in Lakeland Village and expressed her concern for the need of road improvements in the area.

6. Lakeland Village CAC Member Comments: Barbara Dye, expressed concerns over the possibility of a new homeless camp and requested it be on the agenda next month.
